

FACULTY POSITION AVAILABLE

The Department of Mathematics at Stanford University is seeking applicants for one or more Szegö assistant professor appointments. These appointments are for a term of three years, beginning in September 2010. Areas of interest include, but are not limited to, (1) analysis; (2) algebra, number theory, or logic; (3) geometry or topology; (4) combinatorics; (5) applied mathematics or probability; and (6) financial mathematics.

Candidates are expected to show outstanding promise in research, as well as strong interest and ability in teaching, and will be expected to teach courses at both the graduate and undergraduate levels. They must have received the Ph.D. prior to the start of the appointment, but not before 2008.

Applicants should send curriculum vitae, a list of publications, a brief statement of research interest, and names and addresses of three references. For full consideration, materials must be received by December 15, 2009.
